With the entrance of the 1934 class there are 210 alumni on the rolls. Of this total, 108 are girls and 102 are boys.

The increasing size of the classes is shown by a comparison of periods. In the first ten years 22 were graduated; in the second ten year period, 89; while the last six classes total 99 in number.

Of those graduating, seven have died. They are Class of Edith Erickson,/1913; Grace fuss, 1914; Charles Sommer, 1915; Albert Sommer, 1922; Ida Arobio, 1926; Edward Anderson, 1924; and John Hubbard, 1928.

Of the 210 alumni only three have made their homes. East of the Mississippi River. They are Bickford Shields, Urbana, Illinois; Ennes J. O'Connell, Rochester, New York; and Homer J. O'Connell, New York Vity.

Four couples belong to the Akumni. (That is an alumnus has married another alumnus). They are Mr. & Mrs. Glarence Sommers (Marjorie Simpson), Mr. & Mrs. Leslie Kofoed (Frances Morse), Mr. and Mrs. Hybert Neal (Irene Holmstrom), and Mrs. & Mrs. George Lang (Nevada Romwall).

All six of the Lang family are members. They are Jane - 1922, George - 1925, Joe - 1929, Lawrence - 1931, John - 1932, and Mabel - 1933.

Five Gottschalks are now members and the youngest will araduate in 1938.

In 1933 there were ninety graduates at the Banquet held in the Big Meadow Cafe, and some four hundred people attended the Bwelfth Annual Ball held at Arobio Hall.
